Information regarding Submitting Entries

This show is non-juried and any current member of PSC may submit one or two pieces to the show. If space becomes limited we may hang only one piece per artist. Please do not submit artwork that has previously been displayed at the Justice Center. There is no theme for this show.

Please complete one copy of the entry form that follows for each piece you will be submitting and tape the form to the back of the artwork.

Please email the information on the entry form to Ellen White at by April 1st, 2018. This will allow us time to develop a schematic for how the artwork will be displayed and to print display tags to go along with your entries. In addition to emailing the information on the entry form to Ellen, we are asking that you also email a photo of the art work to her. This will allow us to begin developing a plan for hanging the show.

Members may submit 2-dimensional and 3-dimensional work. There are some space limitations on displaying 3-dimensional work (such as artists books) so we ask that you call JoAnn Pari-Mueller at 503-324-4441 if you are considering submitting a 3-dimensional piece with any single dimension greater than 12 inches.

Information regarding Delivery and Pick-up of Artwork

We are not making arrangements for Drop-off sites for this exhibit.

There is a simple rationale for this change. Most people package their artwork very well but some do not. Poorly packaged artwork is at risk of being damaged and of damaging the pieces it is being transported with. We do not want to put our volunteers in such a risky situation.

We are asking members to plan to bring their pieces to the Justice Center the morning we hang the show - Sunday, April 15. We will inform you of a specific time to drop the work off closer to the installation date. Members will need to unwrap their artwork on site and take the packaging home with them. Members will also need to come to the Justice Center to pick up their artwork on Sunday, June 3rd. The time for doing this will be determined later. You will need to bring packaging material.

We understand that asking members to deliver and pick up their artwork without offering drop off sites is not our usual procedures and that this change may be problematic for some of us. If you are unable to deliver or pick up your work and are unable to find a calligraphic colleague to do this for you, please call or email Larry Whitson at 503-349-5305 or whitalex@comcast.net.

Items may be listed as "Not for Sale" or with a sales price. There will be no commission taken on sales. Interested buyers will be directed to the artist who will be responsible for completing the sale and handling the delivery after the show has been taken down.

Entry Identification Form: Tape to BACK of the artwork.

- If you are sending your work with someone other than yourself, please tape a copy to the outside of the packaging as well.
- If you are submitting two pieces of work, please indicate first choice and second choice on the entry form as we may not be able to hang both pieces if space gets tight.
- in order to be officially registered you need to email Ellen White (ellen@kittycentral.us) with all of the information included on the form below.
