Oregon Society of Artists (OSA)/ Portland Society for Calligraphy (PSC)
Non-Juried Joint Show
July 8 – July 31, 2018

**We ask that PSC, VCG, and CC members notify JoAnn Pari-Mueller at hungarianjo@aol by July 1st of their intent to enter the show and the number of framed pieces they will be bringing in order for us to properly estimate the number of works in the show.

Eligibility: Current members of OSA and PSC along with area high school calligraphy students. We will also invite the Valley Calligraphy Guild (VCG) in Eugene and Capital Calligraphers (CC) in Salem to participate.

Entry Fees: \$25 for up to 3 pieces and \$15 for HS students. This is less than the usual fee in order to promote this new relationship between OSA and PSC.

General: This is an open (non-juried) show; PSC (& HS students, VCG, CC) shall submit 60 framed works and OSA shall submit up to 20. The gallery reserves the right to reject artwork that crosses acceptable boundaries. This would include misogynistic imagery, depiction of extreme violence or graphic sexuality, and objectionable political or religious imagery.

Size/Mat/Frame: Works must be framed and ready to hang with an outside dimension not to exceed 48". Artwork that exceeds 30" in any dimension must utilize plexiglass instead of standard glass. Frames must use D-rings mounted 4" from top of frame and wire must be tight in order to be compatible with the hanging system. Matting is optional, but if used must be neutral in color. Gallery frames in black wood or metal are preferred and should be new or in excellent condition. ***For this one show only, artwork will be allowed that was previously framed even if the frame or mat is not as listed above. Artists will be responsible for delivering and picking up their artwork on the dates and times listed above. By participating, you agree to the terms of this prospectus. OSA can only accommodate framed pieces so no books will be displayed in this show.

Sales: OSA shall collect a 15% commission on all work sold. They will collect funds from buyers and provide payment to the artist at pickup. Any artwork that is sold must remain on exhibit for the duration of the show. An authorized PSC volunteer may pick up commissions at the end of the show.

Release & fees & gallery sitting: You must download and complete OSA's Art Show Release Form which is available on the OSA website. The form shall be attached to works delivered to OSA. Please label the back of your work with at least your name and title of your work. Artists living in the greater Portland area will be required to gallery sit M-Sat. from 1-4PM during show dates (July 8-July 30). Sign up for gallery sitting dates at the time of take in.

Postcard: OSA will prepare a postcard for the show and will use one of the photos submitted by PSC.

Title Cards: OSA will prepare title cards for the wall based on the take in information provided by the artist.

Reception: PSC shall provide for and host the reception and provide refreshments (food and beverages) along with plates, napkins, and beverage cups for the appropriate number of people that are estimated to come. OSA will have 2 volunteers on hand to assist with set up and clean up (12:30-3:30 on July 8th).

Volunteers: PSC will provide 2-4 volunteers to assist OSA volunteers with take in on July 5th (10A-3PM) and July 6th (10AM-1PM). PSC will also provide 2 volunteers to assist OSA volunteers with hanging the show on July 7, beginning at 10AM. Hanging of the show will be coordinated by Greg J Lewis at www.greglewisstudios.net.

PSC will be responsible for announcing/advertising to their membership the prospectus, public relations and news releases other than the postcard produced by OSA. PSC shall use their usual resources for marketing the show and OSA will use their usual resources which includes their webpage, the postcard, and email announcements.
