



Portland Society for Calligraphy Workshop Scholarship Policy

A limited number of seats in each PSC workshop are available on a first-come, first-served basis to PSC members or to individuals who are students and non-members. PSC will underwrite up to three partial scholarships per workshop.

Eligibility and Application

To receive a scholarship the recipient must be:

1. A member in good standing
2. A full-time student;
3. An individual who is neither a full-time student nor a member in good standing who submits an application WITH a recommendation from an instructor.

To apply for this scholarship, please submit:

1. A completed application form and
2. A workshop registration form.
3. A new member registration form (available on the PSC website) if the applicants is not a member, and
4. Payment for 50% of the workshop fee, and the additional non-member charge if the applicant is not a member.

The scholarship application is due in accordance with registration policies, and all registration policies apply to scholarship applicants.

The Scholarship Committee shall process applications and select scholarship recipients and the workshop chair shall notify the applicant of the Scholarship Committee's decision within 12 days of receiving the application.

Scholarship Frequency and Amounts:

Scholarships shall not exceed one-half the workshop fee. If a scholarship is not granted, the recipient shall pay any balance of the fees associated with workshops within seven (7) days of receiving notice that the scholarship has not been granted or the application will be withdrawn.

Members are eligible for only one scholarship award per year.

Funds Awarded:

Funds awarded by the Scholarship Committee will be disbursed as Guild \$ (dollars) to the registrar of the workshop. No actual funds will be issued to the scholarship recipient.
