SUPPLY LIST

- Small cutting mat
- X-acto knife with comfort grip (your fingers will thank you for the comfort grip!)
- #11 replacement blades
- Scissors
- 12" cork-back metal ruler
- Mechanical pencil, 0.5 lead HB
- Tombow Mono Aqua liquid glue with the BLUE cap
- If you have it, either an embossing stylus or a burnisher. I've seen the embossing stylus at Jo-Anns and Michaels. If you don't have stylus or burnisher, a dead ballpoint pen (with the ink cartridge removed) will work.

If time allows, we will work on creating your own papercut lettering design. If this interests you, please be prepared with:

- Single word or name (keep it relatively short, max 6 letters), written in your favourite broad-edge script, and enlarged to at least an x-height of 1.5 inches.

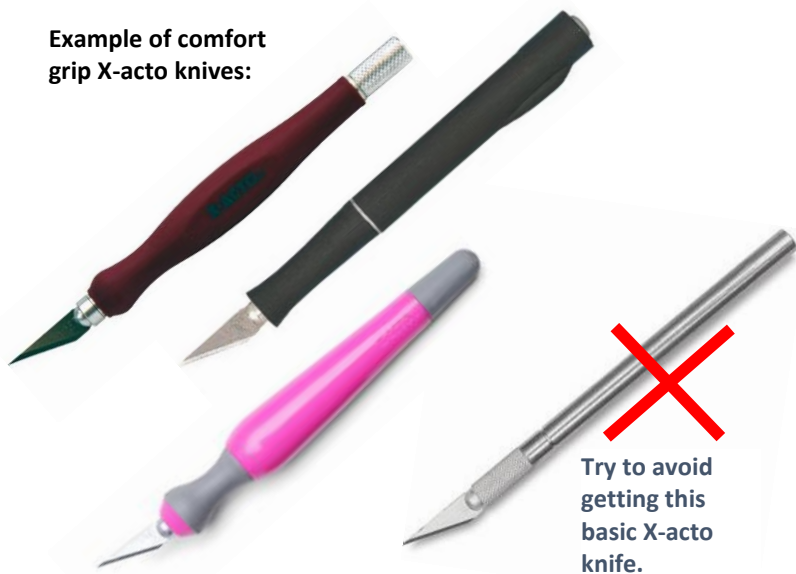
Optional Supplies

- Colourful & patterned scrap paper to be used in the background of the letter
- "X-acto X-light knife": An X-acto knife with an LED light which is very helpful when cutting black paper
- Tombow Mono Zero round mechanical eraser
- 4B or 6B pencil, sharpened
- Tweezers
- Toothpicks
- Small roll of washi tape
